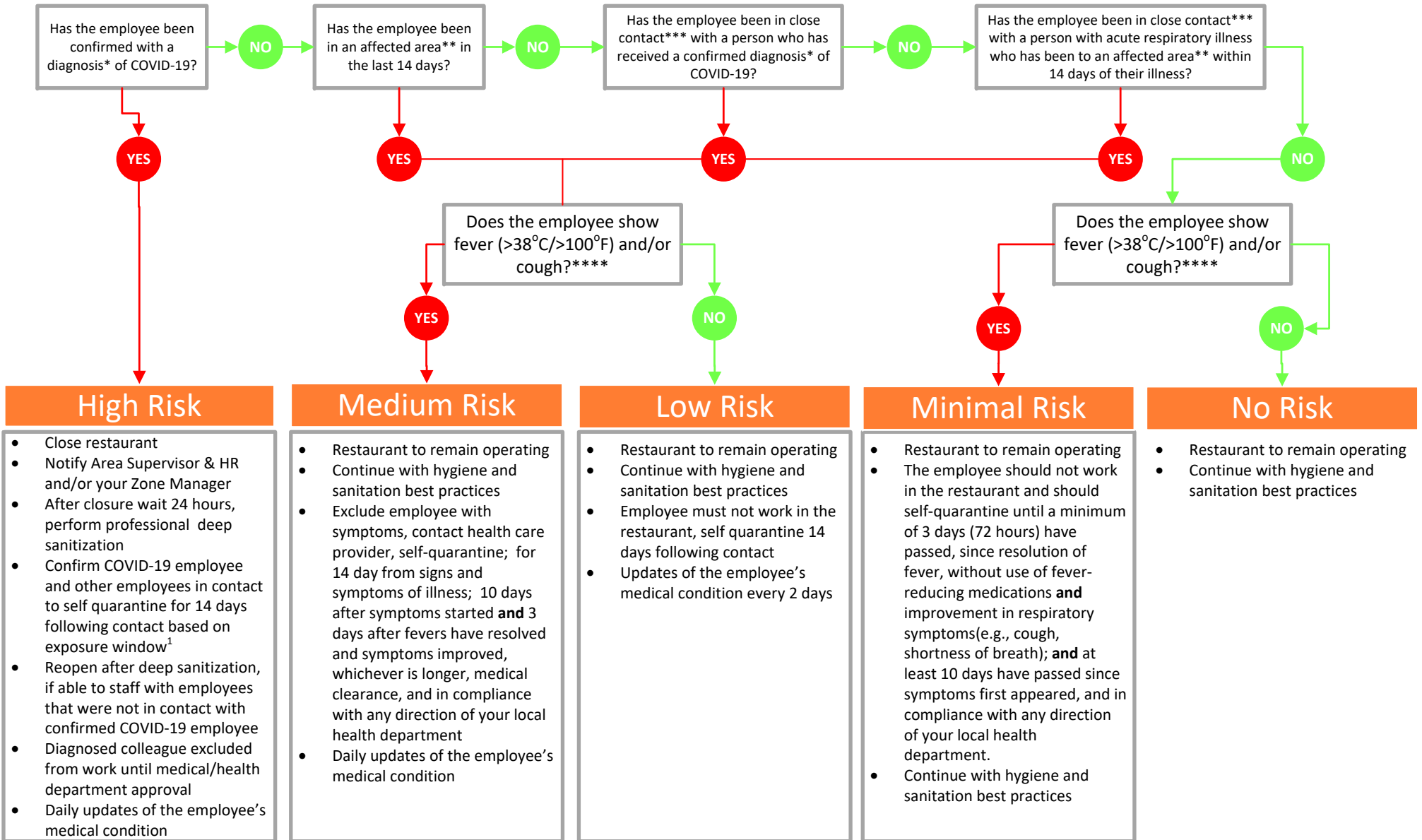

# COVID-19 DECISION TREE FOR RESTAURANT CLOSURES



1. Exposure Window – Two days prior of when signs & symptoms began, for those who are asymptomatic exposure window begins on date of testing.

\*Confirmed diagnosis is defined as written diagnosis of COVID-19 by a health department official or by a medical doctor. It also includes cases with initial test positive, pending verification

\*\* Affected areas: Please use the list of affected areas for your jurisdiction

\*\*\*Close contact is defined as less than 2 meters (6 feet) for a prolonged period of time. It also includes contact with bodily fluids

\*\*\*\* Fever and/or Cough: ideally, the employee should check themselves at home for fever and cough, and not wait to arrive at the restaurant
